Summer Day Camp General Information

WHO: Students who have completed grades K – 5 and are between the ages of 6 -12.
(Students must be 6 years of age by 6/3/19 to attend; Students must remain 12 years of age through 8/2/19 to attend)

WHEN: 6:30 am – 6:00 pm
June 3 – August 2, 2019

CLOSED - NO CAMP:
Week of July 1 – 5, 2019

WHERE: Lagonda Elementary School

GROUPS: Children will be divided into groups based upon the grade they just completed. They will remain in this group throughout the summer.

Group A = Students who completed grades K, 1, 2

Group B = Students who completed grades 3, 4, 5

SNACKS & LUNCHES:

- Students will be served breakfast and an afternoon snack daily.
- Parents are asked to send a nutritious packed lunch with drink daily (No soda pop or candy).
- Staff will have access to a cooler to keep your child's lunch cold, but will not have access to microwaves to "warm up" your child's lunch. Please pack accordingly.

CAMPERS WILL NEED:

1. Daily Smile
2. Sunscreen
3. Packed lunch – daily
4. **Closed toe shoes** (flip flops & sandals present a safety hazard)

STAFF WILL OFFER:

1. Daily Smile
2. A caring and enriching environment.
3. Activities that support academic, physical, and social growth of students.

Summer Day Camp 2019 offers a wide variety of activities that support the social, physical and academic needs of the children in our care. Staff are planning activities to challenge students in fun new ways. Your child will participate in relay challenges, science exploration, cooking activities, art and craft projects, sports, water play, field trips and more. We ask children to keep an open mind, try something new and have lots of fun. (***Students attending camp are required to participate in all planned daily activities.***)

Field Trips: This summer we will offer several weekly enrichment field trips that will take place at Lagonda Elementary and in the Springfield area. Children must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the field trip or bus departure on these days. If your child does not arrive on time they will not be permitted to attend the field trip. It is important that children are in attendance for the pre-field trip briefing. ***Discounts will not be provided if your child misses the trip.***

Summer Day Camp Fees & Rates:

REGISTRATION FEE: \$25.00 for one child or \$40.00 for a family is required at the time of Summer Camp registration. This registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

ACTIVITY FEE: One time activity fee of \$10.00 per child is required at the time of registration. This activity fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

DEPOSIT FEE: A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$10.00 per child, per week is required at the time of registration. The weekly balance must be paid in advance and no later than on the first day you drop your child off at the program each week. The deposit is part of the total fee for the week and not an additional charge.

RATE PLANS:

_____ **WEEKLY RATE PLAN:**

\$125.00 per week, per child. A 10% discount will be applied for additional siblings enrolled and actively attending. Fees must be paid in full at the beginning of each week

_____ **DAILY RATE PLAN:**

\$31.00 per child, per day. If you choose the daily rate plan you will need to indicate the day(s) your child will attend at the time of registration. You will be charged for those days, even if your child does not attend. *No sibling discount applies for the daily rate.*

_____ **TITLE XX APPROVED:**

If you qualify for assistance from the Department of Job and Family Services **the SACC office must have a copy of your current authorization form before your child may attend. Any assigned co-pay must be paid in full each week. All attendance must be completed and accurate in the TAP system within 2 weeks of the attendance date. Failure to comply with any of the above will result in removal from the program.**

If you choose to use our Summer Day Camp, be sure to notify your caseworker that you need authorization for Lagonda. And make sure it is for the correct number of hours.

If for any reason DJFS does not pay us for your child's attendance in the program, you will be responsible for the fees.

Rates are not pro-rated for any reason including holidays, illness, family vacations or non-use. **Reminder, registration and activity fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

Financial Assistance (Title XX):

Financial assistance is available to qualifying families through the Clark County Department of Job and Family Services (DJFS). **If you are already authorized for child care assistance it is important for you to notify DJFS that you will need approval for care at Lagonda during the summer break. An authorization form must be on file with the correct site and the correct number of approved hours in the SACC office before your child may attend.**

Parents must apply directly to The Department of Job and Family Services. Requirements are: parents must be employed or participating in a training or educational activity. Eligibility is based on the family size and gross monthly income.

If determined eligible to receive assistance, the family will be assessed a weekly fee.

Your fee must be paid in full at the end of each week. If your fee is not paid in full at that time your child will not be permitted to attend the program until the fee is paid in full.

DJFS now requires time and attendance through a TAP system. All attendance must be completed the week of service. You must still manually sign your child in and out of the program. Any missed back attendance must be completed within two weeks.

If DJFS does not pay for your child's attendance for any reason, you are responsible for the self-pay rate indicated on the previous page.
