As you are aware, earlier today, Governor DeWine advised all schools in the State of Ohio to close for three (3) weeks beginning at the end of the school day on Monday, March 16, 2020. This afternoon, the District Emergency Operations Team gathered to begin the implementation of the District plan.

This evening, we will provide you with initial information as we prepare for extended time away from school. It is anticipated that the Ohio Department of Education will provide the District with guidelines tomorrow, which will allow for additional communication to parents and students.

### **At-Home Learning**

On Monday March 16, all K-8 students will receive a Student Work Packet consisting of instructions and expectations for lessons in language arts, math, science and social studies.

Students in grades 9-12 will be expected to access their Student Work Packets electronically through their school-issued iPad. Paper packets will be available for students who currently do not have a device and on a limited basis for others.

The completed work packets will be counted for grades toward core content classes (ELA, Math, SS, and Science) and will be counted as attendance for the time that the District is not in session due to the precautions taken related to COVID-19.
